

Freegal Music Instructions Via App updated 02.08.17

1. Download the Freegal Music app from your app store
2. Open the app.
 - a. The first time you use Freegal you will be prompted to enter your zip code then select “Go”.
 - b. Select the name of the library, James Kennedy Public Library
 - c. Enter the number from underneath the barcode on your JKPL library card then select “Login”. You must be a full service patron.
 - d. Agree to the Terms and Conditions of use by selecting “Agree”.
3. Browse for music by artist, song title, album title, or video by typing in search to the field with the magnifying glass. Or find a song by selecting “Browse” from the menu at the bottom of the screen and using their lists.
4. Click on the blue arrow to hear a sample of the song. Click on the white arrow to download the song.
5. Songs download into the My Music folder in Freegal, accessible via the menu at the bottom of the screen.
6. You may download 3 songs per week (Sunday-Saturday). Music is yours to keep.
 - a. Videos are considered 2 downloads.

Freegal Music Instructions Via Computer updated 02.08.17

1. Go to www.dyersville.lib.ia.us
2. Select *Freegal* from the Home page
3. Enter the number from underneath the barcode on your JKPL library card to login then click “Login”. You must be a full service patron.
4. Browse for music in the search box by artist, song title, album title or video.
5. Click on the $\frac{3}{4}$ circle to the left of the song title to hear a sample. Click on the box with the 3 lines and + sign to the right of the song to either add to your Wish List or Download.
6. Songs download into your Downloads folder on your computer.
7. You can manually transfer songs to your iTunes, iPod or MP3 player.
8. You may download 3 songs per week (Sunday-Saturday). Music is yours to keep.
 - a. Videos are considered 2 downloads.

To Stream Music: updated 12/10/18

1. To create your own playlist (These instructions work for both app and computer)
 - a. Go to “My Music”.
 - b. Click on the Playlist Tab.
 - i. Click on the + sign to create a new playlist
 - ii. Name the Playlist.
 - iii. Go back to My Music and click on the Music tab.
 - iv. Go to the song in your collection you want to add to the playlist
 1. To add a song to a playlist you must have already downloaded it.
 - v. There are three dots in a vertical line next to the song information, click on that.
 - vi. Click on “Add to Playlist”.
 - vii. When you have your playlist ready, go back to the Playlist and click on play.
 1. Remember you have 5 hours of streaming per week.
2. To use a playlist already on Freegal
 - a. On the Home screen there are featured Playlists. You can use one of them or search for one using the search bar at the top of the screen.
 - i. Once you find a Playlist, click on the one you want to list to.
 - ii. There will be a list of songs under the playlist. You have two options above them: shuffle or stream.
 1. Shuffle will randomize the songs in the list. Stream will play them in the exact order you see.
 - iii. Click either stream or shuffle and the box next to those options. All the songs will have a box on the right that should be checked.
 - iv. Press play on one of the songs. An option box for playing/pausing, volume, etc will appear at the bottom of the screen.
 - v. Enjoy the music! Just remember you are limited to 5 hours per week.
