JKPL is a Star Library!



The JKPL received a 4 star rating in the \$200,000 to \$399,999 expenditure range category in *Library Journal's* "America's Star Libraries 2014: the LJ Index of Public Library Service" published this month. We are the only Iowa library to be ranked in this category and we are number 15 out of the more than 1,200 libraries in this expenditure category. Last year we were 17th so our national ranking has increased. This is the 7th year that *Library Journal* has released this index and the JKPL has been a star library all seven years. *Library Journal*, a national publication for libraries, publishes this index which compares libraries within an expenditure

range, based upon four measures of use per capita – visits, circulation, program attendance, and public Internet terminal use. The data for this index came from 2012 data released by the Institute of Museum and Library Services.




The JKPL was one of 3 rural lowa public libraries and one of 75 nationally that was selected to receive a \$2500 grant from the National Science Foundation to host this science based reading, viewing, and discussing series. Diane May, head of the Science Department at Beckman Catholic High School, served as the science scholar who lead and moderated discussions on eight books.



Of Special Note...

- ⇒ The library's Adopt-a-book program brought in \$770.00. With this program, people donate the funds for specific items that they want added to the collection and then are the first to read it.
- ⇒ The library raised \$2,882.00 at the Marketing Committee's Fundraising Events Quilt Raffle, Fall Wreath-it-up, Christmas Cookie Walk and Build-a-Basket. These funds were allocated to enhance the library's physical and electronic collections.
