JKPL is a Star Library!

The JKPL received a 4 star rating in the \$200,000 to \$399,999 expenditure range category in Library Journal's "America's Star Libraries 2016: the LJ Index of Public Library Service" published in November, 2016. We are the only lowa library to be ranked in this category and we are number 18 out of the 1,171 libraries in this expenditure category. This is the 9th year that Library Journal has released this index and the JKPL has been a star library all nine years. Library Journal is a national publication for libraries. It publishes this index which compares libraries within an expenditure range, based upon five measures of use per capita - visits, circulation, program attendance, and public Internet terminal use, and new this year - electronic circulation. The data for this index came from 2014 data released by the Institute of Museum and Library Services.



We are blessed to have such a worthy facility as the James Kennedy Library in Dyersville.






