In 2016, the James Kennedy Public Library was one of only fifteen libraries selected to participate in the Small Libraries Create Smart Spaces Project. This two-year project, funded by a National Leadership Grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services, provided training, support, and funding for the JKPL to transform a part of the library facility into a smart space that would meet the active learning needs of the Dyersville community. Based on community input, the library space and collection were reorganized to create the **Creation Station**. This new space provides a flexible, multipurpose location for Do It Together (DIT), Do It Yourself (DIY), and Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Mathematics (STEAM) activities. Including robots, circuits, building blocks, crafting, coloring, and more - the Creation Station provides opportunities for learning, creating, making, and doing. **COME CHECK IT OUT!**




