- ★ For ages 18 or older with a James Kennedy Public Library card
- ★ Sign up in person at the library
- ★ Choose a book bag, bookmark and free book when signing up
- ★ Earn prizes by doing any of the following activities:
 - ⇒ Reading or listening to books, newspapers and magazines
 - ⇒ Participating in programs and activities
 - ⇒ Using library electronic services such as Library Chef (learn how to cook), Craft and Hobby (try out a new hobby), Mango (learn a language), Ancestry (learn about your family history), and AtoZ World Culture (learn about other countries). *These are examples—others are available! Check out the JKPL website or ask a librarian.*
- ★ Completed activities should be tracked on facing page.
- ★ For each 4 items completed, the participant's name will be entered into a drawing for prizes and participants will be able to select a book to add to their home library or an item from the prize box.
- ★ Participants completing the chart (sixteen activities), which must include reading at least four items, will have completed the program. They will earn a special prize and have a chance to enter the Grand Prize Drawings: Win 2 ski rental / lift passes (value \$300 donated by Sundown), a Book Lover's Basket, a JKPL Swag Basket, an Arts and Crafts basket and more.

Participants may continue earning prizes throughout the summer but are only eligible for one grand prize entry.

Color Our World: Book Genre Bingo! June, July, August. Pick up a bingo form and read different genres. Each bingo earns a book from the SLP book cart, a scratch card / prize and an entry into a prize drawing. Complete a black out bingo and automatically earn an Adopt-a-book form. Up to eight of the books read for bingos may also be included for the traditional Summer Library Program.

Color Our World: Reading Recommendations: June, July, August. When you finish a book you love, pick up a special bookmark and share why it should be read. Give the bookmark to a staff member to get your name entered into a drawing.

Color Our World: Favorite Color: June 1-30. What is your favorite rainbow color? Share your response every time you visit the library by putting a pom-pom in the jar that matches your choice. Each response also earns an entry into a drawing. Other art related questions will be asked in July and August.

Creation Station Craft: Coffee Filter Carnations: June 1-30. Make a carnation flower made out of a coffee filter and pipe cleaner. Craft at the JKPL or take home a kit (while supplies last).
