Digital Services Are Available!

While the library is closed, you can still access digital services through the library so you can help the kids keep learning, find something to read or watch, or just amuse yourself. Many vendors are also stepping up during this time to allow access to their services for free. Below is a list of services available to you for free!

James Kennedy Public Library:

Visit the library website at <u>www.dyersville.lib.ia.us</u> and go to the Online Services page to access these three services.

1. eBooks, eAudiobooks, eMagazines from BRIDGES

Borrow digital books, audiobooks, and magazines and load them onto a portable device such as a tablet, eReader, or Smartphone.

- Patrons can download 3 books/audiobooks at a time.
- There are no limits on how many magazines you can check out and they do not count toward the 3 item limit.
- Any item borrowed from BRIDGES has a two week check-out period but you can return items early so you can borrow additional items.

There are two requirements to use BRIDGES:

- You must have a JKPL library card.
- Use is limited to only those patrons who live within the Dyersville city limits, live in one of the cities that contract with the library for service, or anyone who has paid for a membership with the library

**If you live in Delaware or Dubuque County you can still borrow through BRIDGES but you must borrow using the library card from the library considered to be your "home" library. This would be the library in Manchester if you live in Manchester or rural Delaware County; and the Dubuque County Library System if you live in Asbury, Epworth, Farley, Holy Cross, Peosta and rural Dubuque County. If you are not sure if you are eligible, please call the library and we can help you figure it out.

2. Streaming Movies through Kanopy

Kanopy is an on-demand film streaming service that provides access to more than 30,000 of the world's best films, including documentaries, hard-to-find titles, film festival favorites, indie and classic films, and world cinema.

 Films can be streamed from any computer, television, mobile device or platform by downloading the Kanopy app for iOS, Android, AppleTV, Chromecast or Roku. Once accessed, the film is available for viewing for 72 hours.

There are two requirements to use Kanopy:

- You must have a JKPL library card.
- Use is limited to only those patrons who live within the Dyersville city limits, live in one of the cities that contract with the library for service, or anyone who has paid for a membership with the library. If you are not sure if you are eligible, please call the library and we can help you figure it out.

During this time, Kanopy is offering a select list of movies that patrons can watch and downloading the movie will not count against their monthly credits. Also, starting Monday, March 16th Kanopy has opened free, unlimited access to *Kanopy Kids* which offer quality educational content like Sesame Street, Arthur, and language learning series. Free access will be available for 30 days.

3. Downloadable & Streaming Music through Freegal

Download and stream music for free!

- Each patron can download 3 songs each week for free and they are yours to keep. You can even transfer them to a portable device. The week resets each Sunday at midnight.
- Stream up to 5 hours of music per day to listen to.

There are two requirements to use Freegal:

- You must have a JKPL library card.
- Access is limited to any patron who lives within the Dyersville city limits, lives in
 one of the cities that contract with the library for service, or anyone who has paid
 for a membership with the library. If you are not sure if you are eligible, please
 call the library and we can help you figure it out.

4. Transparent Languages & Mango Languages

The library offers two on-line language learning services for our patrons. All you need is a JKPL library card and internet access!

<u>Transparent Language</u>: The most comprehensive, effective, and engaging way to learn over 120 languages, including ESL. Available for all patrons to use.

Mango Languages: Simple language and culture learning in over 70 languages. Mango can be accessed at the library, remotely, or on-the-go with apps for iPhone®, Android™, Kindle® and Nook®.

Please note: this service is limited to full-service patrons which are patrons that either live within the Dyersville city limits, live within the city limits of a city/town that

contracts with the library for service, or a patron that has purchased a membership. If you are not sure if you are eligible, please call the library and we can help you figure it out.

5. Test Prep through BrainFuse: Help Now

Help-Now provides study help for students of all ages including a writing lab, test prep, diagnostic tests, and live on-line tutoring. Free to all patrons. Access this service can be found on the library website on the Services tab.

6. Job Seeking Help through BrainFuse: Job Now

This database offers help for job seekers including a resume lab, job resources, and live job coaching. Free to all patrons. Access this service can be found on the library website on the Research tab.

7. Research through Gale

Offering thousands of vetted articles on hundreds of subjects you will find what you are looking for in Gale.
