This event is a partnership with the Dubuque County Conservation. All ages welcome but guests under 16 years of age need an adult companion. Register by June 14.

  - ⇒ Participating in programs and activities
  - ⇒ Using library electronic services such as Library Chef (learn how to cook), Mango (learn a language), Ancestry (learn about your family history), and AtoZ World Culture (learn about other countries). *These are examples—others are available! Check out the JKPL website or ask a librarian.*
- ✿ Completed activities should be tracked on facing page
- ✿ For each 4 items completed, select an item from the prize box or a book off the cart
- ✿ Finish sixteen activities, which must include reading or listening to at least four books, to complete the program and earn a special prize and chance to enter the Grand Prize Drawings: Book Lover’s Basket, Gardening Basket, JKPL Swag Basket, Arts and Crafts basket and more. Entries to the drawing will be accepted between July 20 and September 4
- ✿ Earn a second grand prize drawing entry by completing at least two bingos on the Book Genre Bingo form

*Participants may continue earning prizes throughout the summer but may only earn one grand prize entry, unless they submit a Bingo form.*
