

***Creation Station S.T.E.A.M Festival
Saturday, March 30 from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm***

Join us at this special event for all ages and discover some of the exciting activities you can try out at the library! There will be several different activities available throughout the day in different spaces of the library. Come for one or come for all! Coloring sheets, crafting, working on a puzzle, and building with LEGOS® will be available all day. The schedule of events is below.

In Creation Station:

10:00 am—12:00 pm: Paint By Stickers: Come create a vibrant, full color “painting” with stickers! As in paint-by-number, each scene is divided into dozens of spaces, each with a number that corresponds to a particular sticker. Find the sticker, peel it, place it. And then the next, and the next, and the next, until your painting comes to life. Come select a painting to make and work on it here at the library then take home to finish. Just want to try it out? Everyone is welcome to come add a sticker or two to our staff paintings and help them come to life! All ages welcome.

12:00—1:00 pm: Washi Tape Dominoes: Make your own set of dominoes using beautiful washi tape. For ages 4 up. Those under age 6 need an adult companion.

1:00—2:00 pm: DoodleBot Mania: Use your imagination to make unique art using a doodlebot! You may keep the artwork you create. For ages 8 to 11.

2:00-4:00 pm: Up-Cycling Greeting Cards: Participants will use the fronts of various greeting cards combined with glue, markers, card stock, and fancy edge scissors to make new greeting cards. This program is for ages 13 and older. Younger participants are welcome with an adult companion.

In Hoffman Room:

12:00-2:00 pm: Birds & Bows: Let’s celebrate Spring by drawing cartoon birds and making colorful bows. Join us for these fun art activities led by Dianne Kramer. All ages welcome.

2:00—3:00 pm: Fun with Robots: Come try out the robots that are available in our Creation Station. Try programming Cue to perform certain actions or have Sphero zip around via wireless control. Participants must be age 7 or older or be accompanied by an adult.

3:00—4:00 pm: Connecting with Circuits: Did you know you can create an alarm clock with Snap circuits? Or turn yourself into a computer controller via Makey-Makey? Come to this session to find out how! For ages 10 and up but younger participants are welcome if they have an adult companion.

In Genealogy Room:

10:00 am—12:00 pm: Craft Stick Catapults: Come build a catapult out of craft

sticks and see what it can do! For ages 5 and up.

1:00—3:00 pm: Paper Airplanes: Come make paper airplanes and see how far they can fly! What is the best design? What flies the best? Come fold and learn with us! For ages 7 and up.

In Game Room:

10 am - 4 pm: Craft Supply Swap: Hey crafters! Looking for "new to you" craft items and ideas? Want to reduce your stash of leftover craft supplies? If your answer to either of these questions is yes, plan to participate in the JKPL Craft Supply Swap. Donate your leftover crafting supplies to the library anytime in March. Return to the library on between 10am and 4pm on Saturday, March 30 to browse the swap and take home the perfect inspiration for your next project. We will accept will accept yarn, fabric, patterns, stickers, embroidery/needlework supplies, paper & cardstock, ribbon, crafting tools, etc. Anything you can use for crafting is welcome! For ages 12 and older.

In Study Room:

10:00 am - 12:00 noon: Button Making: Did you know the library now has a button making machine that you can use? Stop in and try it out! All ages welcome.

12:00 noon - 2:00 pm: 3D Pens: You've heard of 3D printers but did you know about 3D pens? 3D pens blend craft and art and don't require a computer or coding to create your 3D project. Stop in and try out these new tools available at the JKPL. For ages 7 and older.

2:00 - 4:00 pm: Cricut with Christopher: Drop in anytime during these two hours to learn from Lisa Christopher about the Cricut Maker machine. This device can be used for anything from paper crafts, iron-ons, and vinyl decals to sewing projects, leather crafts, and balsa models. Come discover some of the things you can make with this fun crafting and coding machine. For ages 14 and older. Those age 8-13 are welcome with an adult companion.
